- Introduce rainy day attractions and Poole Seafood Festival.
- Quarterly 'Meet the Board' events to provide updates on BID activities and to hear your feedback and suggestions.
- Provide regular levy payer networking groups, including guest speakers on specific topics such as Crime, Regeneration, Grants, HR, Finance, Law etc.
- Official Training/Workshops for members - subsidised First Aid, H\&S, COSHH, Customer Service, Window Dressing \& Refurbishment and Digital Marketing.
